

Preface page:

These fee schedules do not include procedure codes for all provider types. They include Usual, Customary, and Reasonable (UCR) rates, rates for physician services, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, and other practitioners under Section 90, and Durable Medical Equipment (DME) providers. Other rates for MaineCare covered codes for Injectable Drugs, Radiology, Podiatry, Optometry, Vision, Non-Covered Codes and Home Health Non-Routine Supplies are included, as well as Global Surgery Rules.

"Medicare has established a national definition of a global surgical package to ensure that payment is made consistently for the same services across all Medicare contractor jurisdictions. This policy helps prevent payments for services that should be included in the global rates. In addition to the global policy, uniform payment policies and claims processing requirements have been established for other surgical procedures, including bilateral and multiple surgeries, co-surgeons, and team surgeries. "

The Fee Schedules list the components of a global surgical package, billing and payment rules for surgeries, endoscopies, and global surgical packages that are split between two or more physicians. The Global Surgery file lists the Medicare covered codes because MaineCare follows Medicare billing guidelines, but, inclusion in this file does not reflect coverage by MaineCare.

Fee schedules are subject to change. A file with non-covered codes is included and is adjusted regularly. Finding a code in one of these fee schedule files, including the Global Surgery Rules file, does not guarantee that the code is covered.

Tips for using the files:

- .CSV can be saved to any version of excel
- We recommend using freeze top row view in excel
- We recommend that you enable filtering under the data menu
- We recommend that you set the header row to repeat when printing
- Please remember, if printing files, the documents are very large
- We do not recommend working with printed versions as these files are updated weekly
